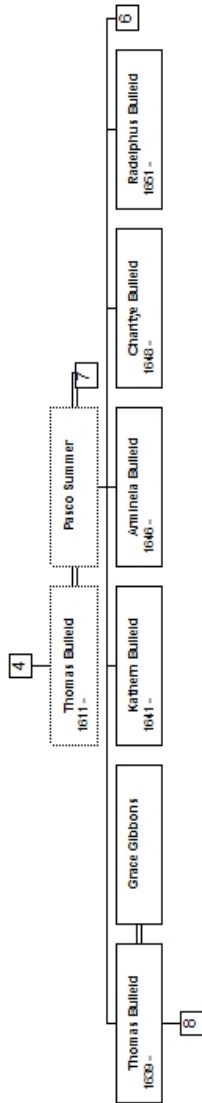
Descendant Tree of Johannis Bulhead

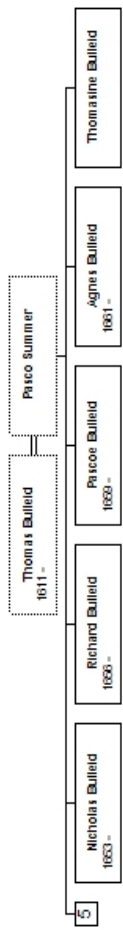


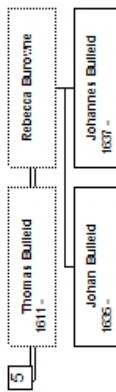


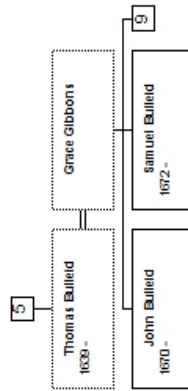


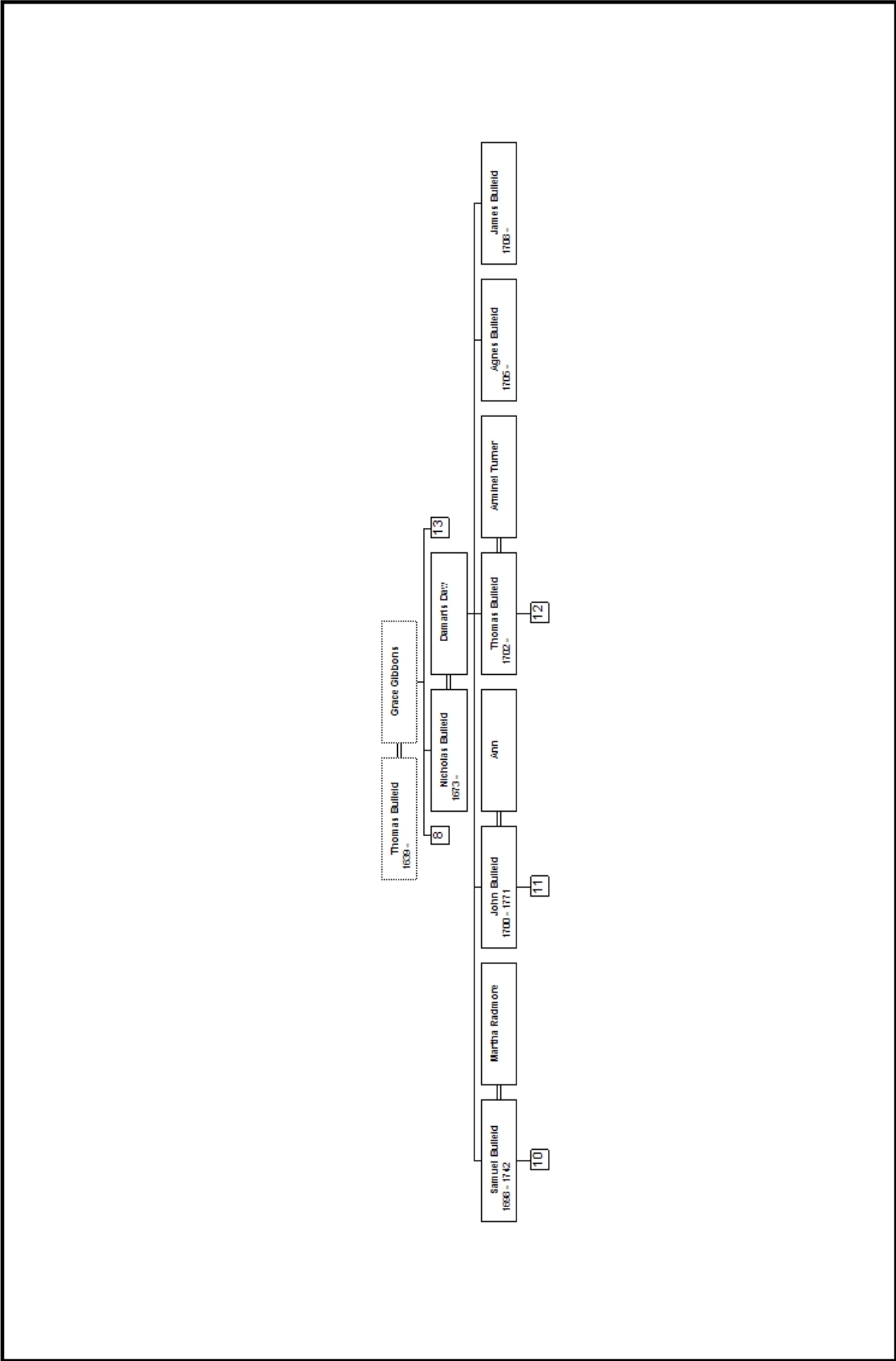


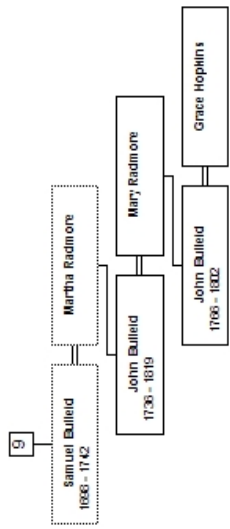


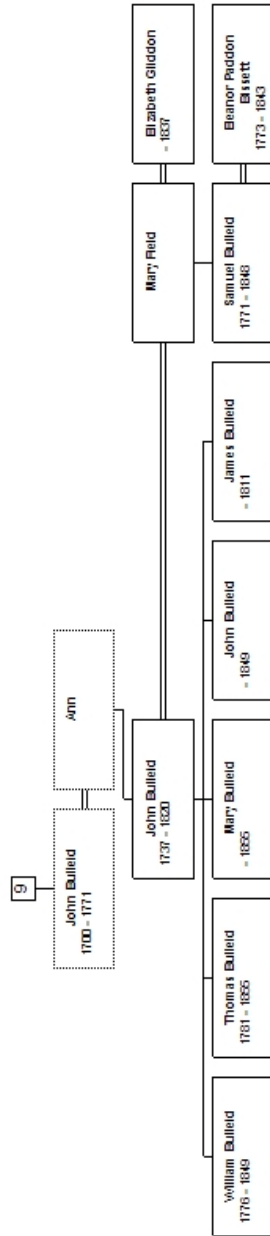


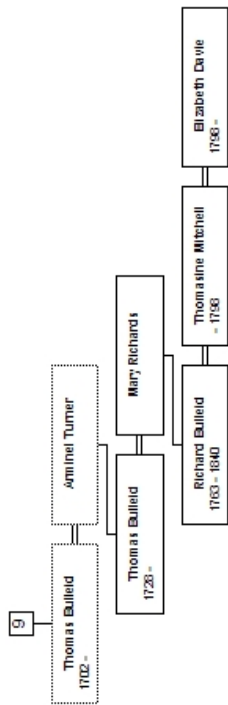


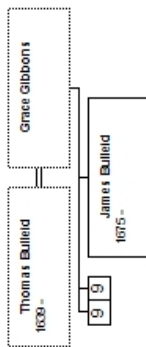

Notes for Richard Bulleid:

[Early Days in Canada from Geoff Ledden April 2009 \(Australia\)](#)

This is a brief account of the hardships that drove a branch of the family to Canada where life must have been tough in the early days. The family survived and flourished, however, and it seems that today there are more members of the Bulleid family in Canada than any other country except England.

Richard Bulleid (1763-1840), son of a butcher in Winkleigh, Devon, England, married twice. His first wife was Thomasine Mitchell by whom he had five sons: Thomas (bp. 1785), Richard (1787), James (1791), Richard (1793) and John (1796). Following the death of Thomasine in 1798, he married Elizabeth Davie, who gave him four more sons: William (1799), George (1803), Charles (1807) and Thomas (1809). Elizabeth died in 1835 and Richard seems to have been left alone as he died five years later in the Union Workhouse in Great Torrington, Devon, of rheumatic fever. It is known that at least three of his sons died young, but why did Richard end his days in the workhouse when others were alive?

Part of the answer seems to lie in the agricultural depression in England during the first half of the 19th century, when thousands of farmers left the land. The UK could not compete with cheaper imports from the new producers in North America and Australia, and many members of the Bulleid family, who had been in agriculture in North Devon for at least three hundred years, moved to the towns and cities. Others went abroad to pursue farming, amongst them Richard's son, Richard, who was baptised in Winkleigh in 1793. Proof that his parents were poor lies in the fact that, at the tender age of eight, he was apprenticed to Richard Davie, almost certainly to learn husbandry until the age of twenty one. No doubt Davie was related to his father's second wife and agreed to help the family.

The next we know of Richard Jr is that he married Elizabeth Ware in Winkleigh on 28th March 1814, when he was twenty or twenty one years old. At the time of the first nationwide census in 1841, Richard was a labourer and had fathered eleven children, the first of whom was Tammy (known as Thomazine). She married Mathew Palmer in Barnstaple, Devon, in 1840 when he was a twenty year-old minor and she was four or five years older. Mathew and Thomazine sailed for Canada three or four years later with children Elizabeth and Elias, settling in Hope Township, Ontario, where their next nine children were born.

They must have sent good reports home because, in 1847, her parents, Richard and Elizabeth, followed them to Canada, with several of their children, including Richard, Ann, Samuel and Thomas.

Thomazine died in 1861 at the age of forty five. Eighteen years later, the body of her husband

Mathew was found in the woods at Port Hope. It seems that he froze to death while on a hunting expedition weeks, possibly months earlier.

The Ashby family had arrived in Canada from Bugbrooke, Northampton, England, about 1840. The mother, Mary Ann, apparently died on the way over, leaving father Thomas with four young children, including the five year old Harriet. Harriet was adopted by a family in Port Hope and was not quite, or barely sixteen when she married Samuel Bullied against her adoptive family's wishes, apparently because Samuel drank heavily. Their first child, Mary Elizabeth, was born six months later.

Samuel's sister Ann married William Parkin in Port Hope in 1850. In September 1852, Samuel was convicted in Port Hope of assaulting William and fined two shillings and sixpence, with costs of one pound six shillings. If those sums were not paid, he was to be imprisoned in the common gaol at Cobourg for fifteen days.

Ann is a widow by the time of the 1861 census when she gives her age as 27. In fact, she was 31 and had three young children, although only two are listed in the census. According to family rumour, she had three children by three different fathers; certainly, she swore an Affidavit of Bastardy in Hope Township in 1859, stating that she had given birth to a daughter on 27th May and that the father was Charles George Fox, Yeoman of Hope. Sadly, Ann ended her days in jail in Lindsay, Ontario, in 1889 and was buried in Riverside Cemetery. Her great grandson, Alan Richards, has written a fuller account of her life entitled "The Black Sheep in our Family", which can be found on the family website.

Samuel and Harriet had ten children. He died in 1905 when The Holland Observer printed the following obituary: -

"On Monday last, March 20, 1905 another of Holland's old timers was called to join the great majority in the person of Mr. Samuel Bullied, who passed peacefully away at his son James' home after a lingering illness of a year's duration, nine months of which he was confined to his bed in a perfectly helpless condition. Deceased was seventy one years and five months of age, and had, up to the time of his illness, been a strong, hardy man, always enjoying the best of health, and one well capable of enduring the hardships of the pioneer settlers of this district. Interment took place in Brookdale Cemetery on Wednesday afternoon, the remains being accompanied to their last resting place by a large number of friends and acquaintances. Deceased was born in the county of Devonshire, England, October 22, 1833 where he resided until he was 15 years of age when he, with his parents, migrated to Canada settling at Port Hope, Ontario. Three years after their arrival in Canada, then a lad of eighteen, he married Miss Harriet Ashby, of Port Hope. In 1887 he came west and took up a homestead about nine miles north of Holland, Manitoba where he resided for a number of years, but of late he has made his home with his son James. He leaves to mourn his loss a wife, five daughters and five sons: Mrs. W. Gibson of Pontypool, Ontario; Mrs. T. Adams of New Park, Ontario; Mrs. T. Thompson of Raglan, Ontario; Mrs. W. R. Adams of New Leskard, Ontario; Mrs. Fred Pascoe, of Killarney, Manitoba; Thomas Bullied of Toronto, Whitney of London, Ontario; Samuel of Treherne, Manitoba; and James and Charlie of Holland, Manitoba. Funeral services will be preached in the Methodist Church on Sunday evening next, by pastor, Rev. J. C. Switzer." The Holland Observer, Mar. 24, 1905.

Harriet survived for a further twenty years, when her death was recorded by The Treherne Times: -

"Bullied, Harriet - The funeral of the late Mrs. Harriet Bullied (nee Ashby) of Holland, Manitoba, was held in the Union Church there on Wednesday, March 4th. Rev. C. Finnemore conducted the service and spoke very highly of the deceased who, in spite of her advanced age, retained all her faculties until the last, and passed away quietly in her sleep at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Pascoe at Killarney, Ontario with whom she has made her home recently. The late Mrs. Bullied was born in Northamptonshire, Eng., on September 29, 1835. She came to Canada when five years of age with her parents, who settled on a farm near Port Hope, Ontario. On September 16, 1851, she married Samuel Bullied, there being ten children born of this union. Mr. Bullied came to Manitoba in 1887 and settled on a farm north of Holland, where Mrs. Bullied joined him later. Mr. Bullied predeceased his wife 20 years ago and a son, Thomas, died in 1916. She leaves five daughters and four sons: Mrs. W.H. Gibson of Peterborough, Ont.; Mrs. Thomas Adams (Maria) of Toronto; Mrs. T.G. Thompson of Raglan, Ont.; Mrs. W.K. Adams of Vancouver; Mrs. Fred.

Pascoe of Killarney; Whitney Bullied of London, Ont.; Samuel Bullied of Treherne, Man.; James and Charles Bullied of Holland. There are also 54 grandchildren and 61 great-grandchildren. The pallbearers were six grandsons, Fred Bullied, Sidney, Merrill, Earle, Frank and Ernest Bullied. Interment took place at Brookdale Cemetery in Holland, Manitoba." [The Treherne Times, Mar. 12, 1925]

Carol Bullied Patterson of Barrie, Ontario, Canada, recently registered as a member of the family website and informed me that her grandfather was Charles Leonard Bullied. Neither of us knew at that stage who his parents were.

She knew that he had married Eva Adams, daughter of Thomas Adams and Maria Bullied, and that Leonard, as he was known, and Eva were reputedly first cousins. The names of both Leonard and Maria were new to me and a bit of sleuthing was called for.

A search on ancestry.com discovered the above obituary for Harriet Ashby Bullied, revealing the identity of Maria as one of her daughters. This connection enabled me to provide Carol with her Bullied ancestry back to John Bulleid and Agnes Heale in the 16th century.

The trick now was to identify Leonard's father, who was thought to be one of Maria's brothers. Again, ancestry provided the answer: his father was Thomas Bullied (1853-1916), Maria's elder brother, who had married Annie Elizabeth Maynard. So Leonard and his wife Frances Eva Adams (1895-1973) were, indeed, first cousins. Had it not been for the fact that two members of ancestry.com had made their Adams trees public, it would not have been so easy to make these connections. One of the members, Jane McLaughlin, had also posted the obituaries of Carol's grandfather (below) and gt gt grandfather: -

Resting at the funeral chapel of William Speers, 2926 Dundas St. W. (near Keele). Service Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 p.m. Interment Prospect Cemetery." [Toronto Star, Dec. 21, 1965]

Notes for Matthew Palmer:

The Palmer brothers came to Treherne in 1875. They were: Ed, Tim [sic - Sim or Simeon], Tom, Ben and Joe. The brothers dug a hole in a hill on SE 13-8-10. They lived in it until they built the log house.

Joe Palmer was born in England. He came to Port Hope, Ontario when he was three years old. He came to Winnipeg via Grand Forks. It took him a total of nineteen days. First, he came by train and then by a flat-bottomed steam boat that came down the Red River. He walked from Winnipeg to Treherne.

Joe took up a homestead in the Treherne area in 1878. He did his pre-emption duties in the winter. In the summer he worked in the No. 6 warehouse on the Red River. In 1878, he walked to Winnipeg (a distance of 105 miles) carrying a blanket and provisions on his back. He made this trip three times that year.

Joe Palmer married Annie Bishop in 1878. . . Mrs. Bessie Ross [daughter] was the first white baby girl born in Treherne. Mr. and Mrs. Palmer walked to Portage la Prairie for supplies. They stayed overnight with the Indians at Long Plain. The Indians on their way to Indian Springs stayed with the Palmers. Mr. Palmer built the first log house in Treherne. . .

BIGLOW

The first and only family of Biglows to come to this district was the family of Mr. and Mrs. William Henry Biglow and their children. Some of the children were born in Ontario and some here. About 1880 this family left the small community of Pontypool, Ontario near Port Hope and took up a homestead on the N.E. quarter of 30-7-10 about four miles due east of Holland. Mrs. Biglow was Mary Palmer. Several of her brothers came west previous to her and her husband and children. The name Palmer was well known in the Treheme district and perhaps their stories of the west was the greatest factor in the Biglows leaving the stony and heavy bush

farmland of Ontario to try for a new living in Manitoba. The Palmers were a big help in settling the Biglow family in their new land.

From the oldest to the youngest with their families, the family of W. H. and Mary Biglow were as follows: Susan, Mrs. James Armstrong, Medicine Hat; Elias John married Elsie Jane Gates whose parents lived on the S.W. Yt 22-7-10; Samuel Edwin married Eccy Taylor whose parents and their family were residents of this district; Emma, Mrs. Arthur Harrison spent all her life in this district, some of her large family still live on the original farm and others still live here; Libby, Mrs. Wm. Scott spent a few years on section 15-7-10 later moving to Winnipeg where her husband managed the Queens Hotel, still later moving to the Gladstone district; William married a Scotch immigrant rather late in life and was of the wandering type and is the only living member of the family. He resides in Vancouver at the present time.

Elias John Biglow homesteaded or bought the N.W. 1/4 29-7-10. The original title to this land issued in the reign of Queen Victoria is still in the family's possession. He married Elsie Gates in 1893 rearing 11 children of which 10 are still living: Bert farmed for 15 years, married Gladys Sanderson of Holland now deceased, retired to Victoria, B.C.; Harry, bookkeeper in Winnipeg, married Marion McCreary of Treherne, was seriously wounded in World War 1. Notes for Joseph S Palmer:

The Palmer brothers came to Treherne in 1875. They were: Ed, Tim [sic - Sim or Simeon], Tom, Ben and Joe. The brothers dug a hole in a hill on SE 13-8-10. They lived in it until they built the log house. Joe Palmer was born in England. He came to Port Hope, Ontario when he was three years old. He came to Winnipeg via Grand Forks. It took him a total of nineteen days. First, he came by train and then by a flat-bottomed steam boat that came down the Red River. He walked from Winnipeg to Treherne.

Joe took up a homestead in the Treherne area in 1878. He did his pre-emption duties in the winter. In the summer he worked in the No. 6 warehouse on the Red River. In 1878, he walked to Winnipeg (a distance of 105 miles) carrying a blanket and provisions on his back. He made this trip three times that year.

Joe Palmer married Annie Bishop in 1878. . . Mrs. Bessie Ross [daughter] was the first white baby girl born in Treherne. Mr. and Mrs. Palmer walked to Portage la Prairie for supplies. They stayed overnight with the Indians at Long Plain. The Indians on their way to Indian Springs stayed with the Palmers. Mr. Palmer built the first log house in Treherne. . .

Notes from Anne Bigelow (Manitoba)

1. It is probable from the above accounts that Samuel Jr. and his cousin, Joseph Palmer, arrived in Winnipeg in 1875. Homestead records prove that Joseph filed for a homestead on NW 18-9-9W near Treherne on 27 May 1878 [homesteads for Bullied not yet checked]. Brother Benjamin Palmer had filed for homestead on 11 May 1878 with Thomas filing on 14 Jun 1878 and Simeon on 12 Jul 1878. The Palmer brothers were all children of Mathew Palmer and Thomasine Bullied, who was a sister to Samuel Bullied Sr.
 2. It was not Joe Palmer who was born in England and came to Canada at age three but rather his oldest sister, Elizabeth, who married John Parker. Joe was born in Hope Twp., Ontario.
 3. Joe Palmer did not marry Annie Bishop in 1878 but rather in 1892 after the birth of five of their children.

THOMAS BULLIED, Township of Chandos, was born in Devonshire, England, 1817. He came to Canada in 1857, and joined his father, Richard Bullied, who had come out from England eight years before and settled in the County of Northumberland, and who now lives in the Township of Manvers, aged ninety years. His mother was a daughter of Thomas Ware. Thomas Bullied was married in England to a daughter of William Tottenton, by whom he had one daughter and eight sons, one of whom is dead. About 1843 he lost a leg in Exeter, England, and was laid up in an hospital for twenty-one weeks. In 1865 he located in Otonabee. He removed from there in 1867, when he came to Chandos, and settled on lot 12, concession 4. He now owns 300 acres of land in Chandos. Mr. Bullied is a Reformer, and a member of the Episcopal Church.

JOHN BULLIED, of lot 29, concession 4, Methuen Township, was born in Devonshire, England, in 1843, and is a son of Thomas Bullied, who came with his family to this country in 1857, and settled in the Township of Chandos. John remained with his people until 1873, when he moved to Anstruther Township and lived there for five years. He then came to Methuen and rented the farm of 600 acres which he still occupies. Mr. Bullied married, in 1873, Catharine Wilson, daughter of John Wilson, of Chandos Township, whose native country is Ireland. They have a family of two sons and three daughters.

RICHARD BULLIED, of Chandos, was born in Devonshire, England, and was the youngest of a family of seven children. His father was Richard Bullied, and his mother was a daughter of Thomas Ware--all natives of Devonshire--where their ancestors had lived for many generations. In 1847 Mr. Bullied, sen'r, with his family, emigrated to Canada, and settled on lot 20, concession 2, of Hope Township, near Port Britani (sic - should be Port Britain - near Port Hope), then a wild lot. From here the various members of the family spread in different directions. Richard remained with his father over four years, helping to clear the farm, at the end of which time he married a daughter of John Gilroy, of the Township of Clarke, and commenced business (farming) on his own account. In 1869 he came with his family to Chandos, and took up lot 2, concession 7. He has since added to this, by the purchase of an adjacent lot; and after years of hard labour now sees the fruits in a fine clearing of 100 acres, on which are good comfortable residences and substantial outbuildings. Mr. Bullied is an Episcopalian in religion, and Liberal in politics. His present independent position is the result of energy, honesty and industry. He is a substantial citizen, a kind neighbour, and highly respected by his entire acquaintance.

GEORGE A. BULLIED, of Chandos, is the eldest son of a family of three sons and seven daughters, of Richard Bullied of Devonshire, who settled in Hope Township, Upper Canada, in 1847, his mother being a Miss Gilroy, of Clarke Township. George was born in Hope in 1859, and was ten years of age when his father removed thence to the Township of Chandos. Ten years later he left his father, and returning to the Township of Clarke, remained there some three years. January 22nd, 1881, he married Sarah, daughter of John Lowery, of Clarke, and early in the present year purchased lots 1, 2 and 3 in concession 6, Chandos, where he now resides. Mr. Bullied has fine improvements, and has started out with the most comfortable surroundings, and under most favourable auspices. The verdict of his acquaintances is that he is a very promising young man, and, barring unforeseen casualties, will make a valuable addition to the citizenship of the back townships.

NOTE in the above the wife is stated as Sarah Lowery, however there are two other documents in the notes from Art Bullied that state his wife was Mary Gilroy who he married in 1881. This is a discrepancy that needs to be cleared up but I have used Mary as the wife as they had seven children. Perhaps Sarah died in early 1881? and he remarried?

Notes for Anne Bullied:

There are interesting notes in the files of Art Bullied that show that Ann died in jail in 1889 and a Pontypool connection.


" The Watchman, Lindsay Sept 5, 1889 Died in Jail: An inquest was held in the jail on Tuesday morning, by Dr Pool, on the body of the late Ann Goheen who died the preceding day. The fact of her death was telegraphed to her friends near Pontypool, by the coroner, but they sent a reply that they could not come, and so she was buried the same afternoon at the expense of the county. The jury besides finding a verdict of "died from natural diseases" added a rider, in which they stated, that, while believing that the jailor does everything possible for those sick under his care a special nurse should be provided for cases of fatal sickness and death." The immediate cause of death, as

showed by Dr Kempt, acting as jail surgeon, was paralysis, which for some time rendered her completely helpless, and as a consequence, a most loathsome object."

This woman had also been in court from Dec 1888 to June 1889 due to a case of bigamy; her second husband "There were grave doubts from the evidence whether or not the prisoner had ever been married to the woman alleged to be his first wife, or if he went through a marriage ceremony with her,....

Notes for Samuel Bullied:

From Allen Richards (Bullied family tree): I have one document that might interest you. It is a court record involving Samuel and my own ancestor, William Parkin, who married Samuel's sister Ann in 1850. I have only two records which mention William -- except for the marriage records of Ann and William's four children which all show him as their father -- and they are the 1850 marriage record and this 1852 court record. William seems to have disappeared after this time. The document as I have it from the archives of Trent University in Peterborough:

United Counties of
Northumberland & Durham

Be it remembered that on the eleventh day of September in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two, at the Town of Port Hope in the said United Counties, Samuel Bullied is convicted before us Nathan Chaote, John Might, and James Grant, three of Her Majesty's Justices of the peace for the said United Counties, for that he the said Samuel Bullied, did on the ninth day of September instant, at the Town of Port Hope in the said United Counties, assault William Parkin, and the said Justices adjudged the said Samuel Bullied for his said offence to

forfeit and pay the sum of two shillings and six pence fine, and also to pay the sum of one pound six shillings for costs; and in default of immediate payment of the said sums to be imprisoned in the common gaol a Cobourg for the space of fifteen days, unless the said sums shall be sooner paid, and we direct that the said sum of two shillings and six pence shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Town of Port Hope, in which the said offence was committed, to be applied according to the form of the statute in that case made and provided; and we order that the said sum of one pound and six shillings for costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Police Court, to pay the expenses of the same - Given under our hands and seals the day and year first above mentioned - John Might JP, James Grant JP.

October 1, 1979 in a letter to Art Bullied from Frank Bullied:

Grandad and grandmother (Samuel and Harriet) came to Manitoba in 1880 they brought Charlie and he was the youngest of the family, he was our father, dad was just thirteen at the time. The parents also located north of Holland near Uncle Jim. The came from Port Hope, Ont. When dad became of legal age, he took a homestead 2 1/2 miles due east of Holland and raised his family there".

See next note from Anne Bigelow, Nov 2008 that shows that Samuel senior moved to Manitoba after 1891:

I believe I may be able to help clear up the confusion about when Samuel Bullied came to the Treherne area in Manitoba. It was his son, Samuel Bullied, born in 1858, who arrived around 1878. I found him on the 1881 Manitoba census for that area, age 23. He is listed with Ben and Edward Palmer, his first cousins. They were among the first settlers in that area. So I think over the years everyone has confused young Samuel with his father, Samuel, who followed him to Manitoba after 1891.

Notes for Harriet Ashby:

The more I think and spend time researching Harriet Ashby the more I feel she had a tough life. Her arrival to Canada was a tough affair in so many ways, the least of which was her losing her mother. Then she was sent to live with strangers to her as in the mid-1800s a single father certainly could not raise children, and if you think about it in the context of the primitive living conditions they arrived into, Thomas was likely working night and day to establish himself in the new land. Then she marries at age 16 and has her first child six months later (a likely but not conclusive statement that she was pregnant when married, which would explain the unwelcome wedding, unwelcome as told by family-lore). In 1852 she was living with her husband in the home of his parents in Hope Twp.

Then she raised a large family and had to move to Manitoba which was far less developed than Ontario. In spite of all this hardship she lived to 74 years! Must have had a internal drive that allowed her to overcome the obstacles. What a pioneer! What a woman.

Harriet Bullied (Note to file, see Bullied Family Tree book I published based on Arthur Bullied research).

29 Sept 1835 - 4 Mar 1925 : The Treherne Times, Mar. 12, 1925.

Bullied, Harriet - The funeral of the late Mrs. Harriet Bullied (nee Ashby) of Holland, Manitoba, was held in the Union Church there on Wednesday, March 4th. Rev. C. Finemore conducted the service and spoke very highly of the deceased who, in spite of her advanced age, retained all her faculties until the last, and passed away quietly in her sleep at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Pascoe at Killarney, Ontario with whom she has made her home recently.

The late Mrs. Bullied was born in Northamptonshire, Eng., on September 29, 1835. She came to Canada when five years of age with her parents, who settled on a farm near Port Hope, Ontario. On September 16, 1851, she married Samuel Bullied, there being ten children born of this union. Mr. Bullied came to Manitoba in 1887 (* note from C Ashby) and settled on a farm north of Holland,

where Mrs. Bullied joined him later. Mr. Bullied predeceased his wife 20 years ago and a son, Thomas, died in 1916. She leaves five daughters and four sons: Mrs. W.H. Gibson of Peterborough, Ont.; Mrs. Thomas Adams (Maria) of Toronto; Mrs. T.G. Thompson of Ragland, Ont.; Mrs. W.K. Adams of Vancouver; Mrs. Fred. Pascoe of Killarney; Whitney Bullied of London, Ont.; Samuel Bullied of Treherne, Man.; James and Charles Bullied of Holland. There are also 54 grandchildren and 61 great-grandchildren.

The pallbearers were six grandsons, Fred Bullied, Sidney, Merril, Earle, Frank and Ernest Bullied. Interment took place at Brookdale Cemetery in Holland, Manitoba.

* this states he moved in 1887, however he is present in 1891 Ontario Census, Durham East. Also note (see NOTES for Samuel Bullied) he came to Manitoba in 1880.

In a letter to Art Bullied from George Thompson dated Nov 21, 1979:

"My mother's mother's name was Harriet. Her mother died on the way over from England leaving her father with 4 small children. Harriet was adopted by a family in Port Hope, Ontario. She married, I thought grandfather Bullied's name was Tom, against this family's wishes as Grandfather Bullied drank very heavily. They had 10 children I believe Lizzie, Charles, Jim, Sam, Cynthia, Whitney, Tom, "girl", Maria and Adelaide. I know more about Aunt Lizzie than the others. She married Henry Gibson who was much older than her. There is a granddaughter Eleanor living in Peterborough."

I have attached a photo of the Holland Mill in Holland, Manitoba. In the items from Eleanor Gibson there was a plaque which likley once had a small calendar on it, I gave this to Sean Ashby in 2014. The plaque was a promotional item from the Holland Mills.

Samuel Bullied and Harriet Ashby had the following children:

- i. MARY ELIZABETH¹¹ BULLIED (daughter of Samuel Bullied and Harriet Ashby) was born on 15 Mar 1852 in Hope, Durham County¹⁴⁴⁻¹⁴⁸. She died on 20 Jan 1945 in Peterborough, Ontario¹⁴⁹⁻¹⁵⁰. She married William Henry Gibson (son of William Gibson and Mary Peart) on 25 Jul 1867 in Manvers Twp, Durham County¹⁵¹⁻¹⁵². He was born on 02 Sep 1841 in Ulceby, Lincolnshire, England¹⁵³⁻¹⁶⁰. He died on 29 Sep 1913 in Holland, Manitoba¹⁶¹⁻¹⁶⁵.



Notes for Mary Elizabeth Bullied:

ME's birth date - here is a classic example of poor record keeping or someone choosing to shave a few years off her birth. The marriage in 1867 states she was 17, in 1871 census she was 19...funny that 4 years passed for everyone but Mary, she managed to age only 2 years. So she could have been born in 1850, 1852 or 1853 - based on information available.

No matter which is correct she lived a full life of about 90 years or more.

It appears that she was in Holland from 1908 to 1915/16. William her husband died in 1913, and she moved into her son Charles' home. In Dec 1916 she was with her sister Adalaide Thompson in Raglan, ON. There are letters from Church to wish her well as she leaves Holland in Nov 1919. It appears this, 1919, is when she moved in with her son Charles.

Jan 22 1945 Died: Gibson, Mrs Mary Elizabeth on Sat Jan 20 1945 at the residence, 131 Murrow St. Mary Elizabeth Bullied in her 93rd year, beloved wife of ghe late William Henry Gibson and mother

of Mrs Thomas Hobbs and Charles Gibson. Funeral service on Tues Jan 23 at 2pm from the residence 131 Murrow St (Peterborough) Internment Pontypool Cemetery

Notes for William Henry Gibson:

The date of Williams' birth - the census for 1891 put him being born in 1842, his marriage record of 1867 places his birth in 1843 (age at marriage stated as 24 years), 1871 census places his birth at 1843.

1871 census information: 2 horses, 2 working oxen, 2 milk cows, 3 larder cows, 3 sheep, 3 swine, 3 sheep and 4 swine slaughtered, killed or exported. 100 pounds of butter, 14 pounds of wool and 12 yards of home made cloth or flannel.

Of the 150 acres he had 90 had been "improved" - 4 in pastures, 6 in gardens or orchards, 6 in wheat, 2 in potatoes and 6 in hay.

Note: 1878 Illustrated Historical Atlas for Northumberland and Durham has a William Gibson at Lot 30, Con 7 in Darlington Twp. This is person is likely not related.

Children

In 2010 when I obtained the family bible I was able to further adjust to show only 6 children: Willam Arthur, Charles Henry, Margaret Sophia, Susana Elizabeth, Alice Maud Mary and Francis Marcellia.

There seems to have been confusion around census time. Could have been that the children's ages just were not remembered, which considering William Henry had 8 and George had 10, and that the two families lived so closely linked may be of little surprise.

Based on the facts of births registered, baptisms and census notes I have made some decisions which include:

1. Margaret G (looks like a G, may have been an S) who was 6 in 1881 is the same person as Sofia who is 15 in 1891. In 1901 she appears as Margret S. 25 and born on July 18, 1875. The initial S appears to have been for Sofia and appears to have been the name used while a child. Her death in 1913 lists her parents and carries the initial S. IN 2009 when I recieved Eleanor Gibson collection - the marriage cert for her shows Margaret Sophie Gibson.

2. Susana E age 4 listed in the 1881 census appears as Susie in the 1891 age 13. She does not appear again. This is supported with a birth registered for SusaNNa E September 24, 1877. Does not appear in 1901 census and there is no death registration that matches for her.

3. Alice MM age 2 in 1881 is Maud age 13 in 1891 and Alice M in 1901 age 21 born Oct 19, 1879. This is supported by the birth registry of Maude Mary born Oct 18, 1879 - William & Mary could not have two children born a day apart unless they were twins and if this

were the case as one was registered so would have been the other. I selected Oct 18 as the actual birth date as it was registered by the family and doctor, the census would more likely be the wrong document. 1911 census has her as Alice Mary Oct 1879. She was at home in 1901, so wedding was between 1901-1911.

4. Frankie and Marcellus may be the same person based on the fact that Marcellus was born in 1885 and Frankie was 6 in 1891 thereby placing his birth about 1885.

1913 Obituary in The Holland Observer, Oct 2 1913: Mr. W H Gibson, **who suffered from paralysis since he came to Holland some eight years ago**, died on Monday, September 29th, aged 72 years. The funeral service was held at the house on Wednesday, Oct 1st, and the remains were interred in Holland Cemetery. The deceased leaves a widow, a son, Charles, who lives near Toronto, and a daughter Mrs. Thos Hobbs of Harriston, Ont.

- ii. THOMAS BULLIED¹⁶⁶ (son of Samuel Bullied and Harriet Ashby) was born on 04 Mar 1854 in Durham, Ontario, Canada^{1, 166-167}. He died on 01 Jun 1916 in Toronto, Ontario, Canada^{1, 168-170}. He married Anne Elizabeth Maynard (daughter of John Maynard and Ashmall Gibson) on 28 Oct 1875 in Manvers Twp, Durham Co, Ontario¹⁷¹. She was born in Jun 1858 in Manvers Township, Durham County, Ontario^{1, 172-173}. She died on 04 Aug 1945^{1, 174}.

Notes for Thomas Bullied:

The 1881 Census for Manvers, listed between the two Gibson brothers (William H and George) are: Thomas Bullied 26, wife Annie E 22, and children Mary E 4, Margaret 4, William 2 and Bertie born in March 1881. All members of the family are noted as being born in Ontario. It is VERY likely that Thomas is the brother of Mary (wife of WH Gibson).

Obit: passed away at his late home, 121 Mavety Avenue, yesterday. Mr. Bullied was seized with paralysis over a year ago, from which he never recovered. He was in his 63rd year and was born near Port Hope. He resided in Havelock for a great number of years, but later engaged in Swift's abattoir for the past ten years. He was a member of High Park Methodist Church, and is survived by his widow, and six children - Mrs. M McKittrick, Trenton. Mrs Bert Higby and Mr William Bullied, Havelock; Mrs Margaret Fallis, also Charles and Clifford Bullied of Toronto.

Notes for Whitney Governor Bullied:

From Anne Bigelow, Manitoba April 2009 : I had a very hard time tracing Whitney Bullied - the only reason I found him was because of his unusual first name. I think that Bullied spoken with an English accent sounds very similar to Bullard or Bulled, and he was probably illiterate (or maybe the children just didn't like the spelling of Bullied). I started finding all his family members listed on the census and even marriage/birth records with the spelling "Bullard." It is not always consistent and is sometimes Bullied. However, it seemed to me by the early 1900's the whole family was using the spelling of Bullard. It would be interesting to trace their descendants to see if they are still using that spelling.

Notes for Samuel Bullied:

Note from Anne Bigelow (Manitoba)

Samuel Bullied was born in 1858 in Port Hope, Ontario. At the age of 17 years, he came with Joe and Ed Palmer, Andy Douglas and Joe Hinton. They came up the Assiniboine River on the old paddle wheel called the "Manitoba" with Captain Sheets in the year 1875.

Sam and the boys worked at jobs they could find. They also worked for the railroad. Sam also helped build the first sidewalks in Treherne. They walked to Portage la Prairie for supplies. There, he met Emma Woodcock, who with her family, came from England. In 1885, they were married in Portage. They had eight children, Mae, Sam, Eva, Ivy, Jean, Vina, Corbett and Verna.

Samuel homesteaded west of Treherne, now the Robert Oliver farm. In 1883, Sam's mother, father and his two brothers came from Port Hope. Jim and Charlie Bullied took up homesteads in Holland. . .

- from Tiger Hills to the Assiniboine, 1976 [written by Verna (Bullied) Brooking]

The Palmers were among the earliest settlers in the Treherne area. Joe Palmer and Sam Bullied left Port Hope, Ontario on the 5th of October, 1875. They landed at Fort Garry [Winnipeg] on October 24, being 19 days and nights on the road. They travelled by boat and rail to Grand Forks, North Dakota (then the end of rail) then by one of the old Red River flatboats, "The Manitoba" under Captain Jim Sheets.

In the spring of 1878, they walked from Winnipeg to what was known then as The Tiger Hills (Treherne). They travelled via Headingly, Poplar Point, High Bluff, Portage la Prairie, Fortney Crossing, Indianford and the Boyne River (The Yellowquill Trail).

Having picked out their homesteads, they tramped back to Winnipeg, carrying their grub and blankets 105 miles each way and making the round trip in six days. This they did for three successive years to prove their claim, leaving Winnipeg in the fall and returning in the spring. During the summer they worked - Joe as baggage master at the No. 6 warehouse and Sam as watchman on one of the Red River boats. . .

Obituary : Maria Adams Bullied August 11, 1860 ~ January 4, 1931

Port McNicoll, Jan. 1931 A well known and highly respected resident of Clarke Township, passed away at the home of her son, Mr. Zack Adams, in this village on January 4, 1931, in the person of Mrs. Thomas Adams in her seventy-first year.

Deceased was a daughter of the late Samuel Bullied and Harriet Ashby. She was born in the Township of Hope in 1860, and lived there until her marriage with Thomas Adams in 1879. From that time she lived on the Adams homestead in Clarke. After the death of Mr. Adams, two years ago, she spent most of her time at Port McNicoll, till Christmas day, when she was stricken with a stroke followed by another a week later. Her patient and loving manner won for her many friends. She was always trying to be of some benefit for others, being a kind and loving mother.

She leaves seven sons: James, Ernest, Wesley and Oscar of Burketon; Sam of Hamilton; Fred of Oshawa and Zack of Port McNicoll, with whom she made her home, and three daughters: Mrs. Richard Winch, Eyebrow, Sask.; Mrs. George Patterson, Orono and Mrs. Leonard Bullied of Weston; also two brothers, Sam and Charlie of Treherne, Man.; four sisters, Mrs. Lizzie Gibson and Mrs. Addie Thompson, Oshawa; Hattie Adams of British Columbia and Mrs. Cynthia Pascoe of Manitoba.

The funeral was held on January 6, 1931, at the home of her son, service being conducted by Rev. A. J. Eagles of Victoria Harbour. The remains being laid to rest in Midland.

The pall-bearers were: Messrs. Sam, Joe and Thomas Evans, George Montgomery, W. M. Callan and Allen Laidlaw of Midland. Midland Free Press, Jan. 26, 1931.

BULLIED

James Bullied came to Holland from Peterborough and Port Hope, Ontario in 1883 at the age of 19, helping to build the railroad. In 1888 he married Minnie Brock and they raised nine children. Mr. Bullied farmed several farms, owned and operated a steam threshing machine with his boys to help him. Mrs. Bullied died in 1947 and her husband died in 1951. Their family of nine children were: Fred, who farmed in Holland district and now lives at Portage La Prairie; Bill, farmed here most of his life; Earl, farmed here until 1945; Merle, a farmer too; Sophia, married Wm. Carnahan and farmed here until 1928; Nellie, Mrs. F. Eagle of Brandon; Cynthia, who lives in Vancouver and Sidney, also a farmer. Sidney married Ethel Knibbs of Stoughton, Saskatchewan in 1925. As well as farming he did a lot of work with his engine building roads between Cypress River and Holland. He passed away in 1950. His widow and son Jack, carried on the farming till 1961 when Mrs. Bullied bought a home in Treherne. Mr. and Mrs. Sid Bullied's family consisted of two boys and two girls. The girls are Phyllis, Mrs. J. McKenzie of Winnipeg and Joyce, Mrs. R. Riddell. Joyce's husband is in the R.C.A.F. and they have been stationed in Germany and are presently in France. They have three children, Ross, Debbie, and Dwane. Jack Bullied farms the home farm and in 1959 married Gwen Sime. Their children are Johnny, Janice, Bobby and Linda. Raymond spent five years in the air force and is now farming four miles north of Holland. He married Betty Burns of Owen Sound, Ontario in 1956 and they have two sons, Bruce and Brian.

Samuel Bullied

From Allen Richards (Bullied family tree): I have one document that might interest you. It is a court record involving Samuel and my own ancestor, William Parkin, who married Samuel's sister Ann in 1850. I have only two records which mention William -- except for the marriage records of Ann and William's four children which all show him as their father -- and they are the 1850 marriage record and this 1852 court record. William seems to have disappeared after this time. The document as I have it from the archives of Trent University in Peterborough:

United Counties of
Northumberland & Durham

Be it remembered that on the eleventh day of September in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two, at the Town of Port Hope in the said United Counties, Samuel Bullied is convicted before us Nathan Chaote, John Might, and James Grant, three of Her Majesty's Justices of the peace for the said United Counties, for that he the said Samuel Bullied, did on the ninth day of September instant, at the Town of Port Hope in the said United Counties, assault William Parkin, and the said Justices adjudged the said Samuel Bullied for his said offence to forfeit and pay the sum of two shillings and six pence fine, and also to pay the sum of one pound six shillings for costs; and in default of immediate payment of the said sums to be imprisoned in the common gaol a Cobourg for the space of fifteen days, unless the said sums shall be sooner paid, and we direct that the said sum of two shillings and six pence shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Town of Port Hope, in which the said offence was committed, to be applied according to the form of the statute in that case made and provided; and we order that the said sum of one pound and six shillings for costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Police Court, to pay the expenses of the same - Given under our hands and seals the day and year first above mentioned - John Might JP, James Grant JP.

October 1, 1979 in a letter to Art Bullied from Frank Bullied:

Grandad and grandmother (Samuel and Harriet) came to Manitoba in 1880 they brought Charlie and he was the youngest of the family, he was our father, dad was just thirteen at the time. The parents also located north of Holland near Uncle Jim. The came from Port Hope, Ont. When dad became of legal age, he took a homestead 2 1/2 miles due east of Holland and raised his family there".

See next note from Anne Bigelow, Nov 2008 that shows that Samuel senior moved to Manitoba after 1891: I believe I may be able to help clear up the confusion about when Samuel Bullied came to the Treherne area in Manitoba. It was his son, Samuel Bullied, born in 1858, who arrived around 1878. I found him on the 1881 Manitoba census for that area, age 23. He is listed with Ben and Edward Palmer, his first cousins. They were among the first settlers in that area. So I think over the years everyone has confused young Samuel with his father, Samuel, who followed him to Manitoba after 1891.

Harriet Ashby

The more I think and spend time researching Harriet Ashby the more I feel she had a tough life. Her arrival to Canada was a tough affair in so many ways, the least of which was her losing her mother. Then

she was sent to live with strangers to her as in the mid-1800s a single father certainly could not raise children, and if you think about it in the context of the primitive living conditions they arrived into, Thomas was likely working night and day to establish himself in the new land. Then she marries at age 16 and has her first child six months later (a likely but not conclusive statement that she was pregnant when married, which would explain the unwelcome wedding, unwelcome as told by family-lore). In 1852 she was living with her husband in the home of his parents in Hope Twp.

Then she raised a large family and had to move to Manitoba which was far less developed than Ontario. In spite of all this hardship she lived to 74 years! Must have had an internal drive that allowed her to overcome the obstacles. What a pioneer! What a woman.

Harriet Bullied (Note to file, see Bullied Family Tree book I published based on Arthur Bullied research).

29 Sept 1835 - 4 Mar 1925 : The Treherne Times, Mar. 12, 1925.

Bullied, Harriet - The funeral of the late Mrs. Harriet Bullied (nee Ashby) of Holland, Manitoba, was held in the Union Church there on Wednesday, March 4th. Rev. C. Finnemore conducted the service and spoke very highly of the deceased who, in spite of her advanced age, retained all her faculties until the last, and passed away quietly in her sleep at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Pascoe at Killarney, Ontario with whom she has made her home recently.

The late Mrs. Bullied was born in Northamptonshire, Eng., on September 29, 1835. She came to Canada when five years of age with her parents, who settled on a farm near Port Hope, Ontario. On September 16, 1851, she married Samuel Bullied, there being ten children born of this union. Mr. Bullied came to Manitoba in 1887 (* note from C Ashby) and settled on a farm north of Holland, where Mrs. Bullied joined him later. Mr. Bullied predeceased his wife 20 years ago and a son, Thomas, died in 1916. She leaves five daughters and four sons: Mrs. W.H. Gibson of Peterborough, Ont.; Mrs. Thomas Adams (Maria) of Toronto; Mrs. T.G. Thompson of Ragland, Ont.; Mrs. W.K. Adams of Vancouver; Mrs. Fred. Pascoe of Killarney; Whitney Bullied of London, Ont.; Samuel Bullied of Treherne, Man.; James and Charles Bullied of Holland. There are also 54 grandchildren and 61 great-grandchildren.

The pallbearers were six grandsons, Fred Bullied, Sidney, Merrill, Earle, Frank and Ernest Bullied. Interment took place at Brookdale Cemetery in Holland, Manitoba.

* this states he moved in 1887, however he is present in 1891 Ontario Census, Durham East. Also note (see NOTES for Samuel Bullied) he came to Manitoba in 1880.

In a letter to Art Bullied from George Thompson dated Nov 21, 1979:

"My mother's mother's name was Harriet. Her mother died on the way over from England leaving her father with 4 small children. Harriet was adopted by a family in Port Hope, Ontario. She married, I thought grandfather Bullied's name was Tom, against this family's wishes as Grandfather Bullied drank very heavily. They had 10 children I believe Lizzie, Charles, Jim, Sam, Cynthia, Whitney, Tom, "girl", Maria and Adelaide. I know more about Aunt Lizzie than the others. She married Henry Gibson who was much older than her. There is a granddaughter Eleanor living in Peterborough."

I have attached a photo of the Holland Mill in Holland, Manitoba. In the items from Eleanor Gibson there was a plaque which likely once had a small calendar on it, I gave this to Sean Ashby in 2014. The plaque was a promotional item from the Holland Mills.

Mary Elizabeth Bullied

ME's birth date - here is a classic example of poor record keeping or someone choosing to shave a few years off her birth. The marriage in 1867 states she was 17, in 1871 census she was 19...funny that 4 years passed for everyone but Mary, she managed to age only 2 years. So she could have been born in 1850, 1852 or 1853 - based on information available.

No matter which is correct she lived a full life of about 90 years or more.

It appears that she was in Holland from 1908 to 1915/16. William her husband died in 1913, and she

moved into her son Charles' home. In Dec 1916 she was with her sister Adalaide Thompson in Raglan, ON. There are letters from Church to wish her well as she leaves Holland in Nov 1919. It appears this, 1919, is when she moved in with her son Charles.

Jan 22 1945 Died: Gibson, Mrs Mary Elizabeth on Sat Jan 20 1945 at the residence, 131 Murrow St. Mary Elizabeth Bullied in her 93rd year, beloved wife of ghe late William Henry Gibson and mother of Mrs Thomas Hobbs and Charles Gibson. Funeral service on Tues Jan 23 at 2pm from the residence 131 Murrow St (Peterborough) Internment Pontypool Cemetery

Thomas Bullied

The 1881 Census for Manvers, listed between the two Gibson brothers (William H and George) are: Thomas Bullied 26, wife Annie E 22, and children Mary E 4, Margaret 4, William 2 and Bertie born in March 1881. All members of the family are noted as being born in Ontario. It is VERY likely that Thomas is the brother of Mary (wife of WH Gibson).

Obit: passed away at his late home, 121 Mavety Avenue, yesterday. Mr. Bullied was seized with paralysis over a year ago, from which he never recovered. He was in his 63rd year and was born near Port Hope. He resided in Havelock for a great nmbor of years, but later engaged in Swift's abattoir for the past ten years. He was a member of High Park Methodist Church, and is survived by his widow, and siz children - Mrs. M McKittrick, Trenton. Mrs Bert Higby adn Mr William Bullied, Havelock; Mrs Margaret Fallis, also Charles and Clifford Bullied of Toronto.

Whitney Governor Bullied

From Anne Bigelow, Manitoba April 2009 : I had a very hard time tracing Whitney Bullied - the only reason I found him was because of his unusual first name. I think that Bullied spoken with an English accent sounds very similar to Bullard or Bulled, and he was probably illiterate (or maybe the children just didn't like the spelling of Bullied). I started finding all his family members listed on the census and even marriage/birth records with the spelling "Bullard." It is not always consistent and is sometimes Bullied. However, it seemed to me by the early 1900's the whole family was using the spelling of Bullard. It would be interesting to trace their descendants to see if they are still using that spelling.

Samuel Bullied

Note from Anne Bigelow (Manitoba)

Samuel Bullied was born in 1858 in Port Hope, Ontario. At the age of 17 years, he came with Joe and Ed Palmer, Andy Douglas and Joe Hinton. They came up the Assiniboine River on the old paddle wheel called the "Manitoba" with Captain Sheets in the year 1875.

Sam and the boys worked at jobs they could find. They also worked for the railroad. Sam also helped build the first sidewalks in Treherne. They walked to Portage la Prairie for supplies. There, he met Emma Woodcock, who with her family, came from England. In 1885, they were married in Portage. They had eight children, Mae, Sam, Eva, Ivy, Jean, Vina, Corbett and Verna.

Samuel homesteaded west of Treherne, now the Robert Oliver farm. In 1883, Sam's mother, father and his two brothers came from Port Hope. Jim and Charlie Bullied took up homesteads in Holland. . . - from Tiger Hills to the Assiniboine, 1976 [written by Verna (Bullied) Brooking]

The Palmers were among the earliest settlers in the Treherne area. Joe Palmer and Sam Bullied left Port Hope, Ontario on the 5th of October, 1875. They landed at Fort Garry [Winnipeg] on October 24, being 19 days and nights on the road. They travelled by boat and rail to Grand Forks, North Dakota (then the end of rail) then by one of the old Red River flatboats, "The Manitoba" under Captain Jim Sheets.

In the spring of 1878, they walked from Winnipeg to what was known then as The Tiger Hills (Treherne). They travelled via Headingly, Poplar Point, High Bluff, Portage la Prairie, Fortney Crossing, Indianford and the Boyne River (The Yellowquill Trail).

Having picked out their homesteads, they tramped back to Winnipeg, carrying their grub and blankets 105 miles each way and making the round trip in six days. This they did for three successive years

to prove their claim, leaving Winnipeg in the fall and returning in the spring. During the summer they worked - Joe as baggage master at the No. 6 warehouse and Sam as watchman on one of the Red River boats. . .

Maria Bullied

Obituary : Maria Adams Bullied August 11, 1860 ~ January 4, 1931

Port McNicoll, Jan. 1931 A well known and highly respected resident of Clarke Township, passed away at the home of her son, Mr. Zack Adams, in this village on January 4, 1931, in the person of Mrs. Thomas Adams in her seventy-first year.

Deceased was a daughter of the late Samuel Bullied and Harriet Ashby. She was born in the Township of Hope in 1860, and lived there until her marriage with Thomas Adams in 1879. From that time she lived on the Adams homestead in Clarke. After the death of Mr. Adams, two years ago, she spent most of her time at Port McNicoll, till Christmas day, when she was stricken with a stroke followed by another a week later. Her patient and loving manner won for her many friends. She was always trying to be of some benefit for others, being a kind and loving mother.

She leaves seven sons: James, Ernest, Wesley and Oscar of Burketon; Sam of Hamilton; Fred of Oshawa and Zack of Port McNicoll, with whom she made her home, and three daughters: Mrs. Richard Winch, Eyebrow, Sask.; Mrs. George Patterson, Orono and Mrs. Leonard Bullied of Weston; also two brothers, Sam and Charlie of Treherne, Man.; four sisters, Mrs. Lizzie Gibson and Mrs. Addie Thompson, Oshawa; Hattie Adams of British Columbia and Mrs. Cynthia Pascoe of Manitoba.

The funeral was held on January 6, 1931, at the home of her son, service being conducted by Rev. A. J. Eagles of Victoria Harbour. The remains being laid to rest in Midland.

The pall-bearers were: Messrs. Sam, Joe and Thomas Evans, George Montgomery, W. M. Callan and Allen Laidlaw of Midland. Midland Free Press, Jan. 26, 1931.

James Bullied

BULLIED

James Bullied came to Holland from Peterborough and Port Hope, Ontario in 1883 at the age of 19, helping to build the railroad. In 1888 he married Minnie Brock and they raised nine children. Mr. Bullied farmed several farms, owned and operated a steam threshing machine with his boys to help him. Mrs. Bullied died in 1947 and her husband died in 1951. Their family of nine children were: Fred, who farmed in Holland district and now lives at Portage La Prairie; Bill, farmed here most of his life; Earl, farmed here until 1945; Merle, a farmer too; Sophia, married Wm. Carnahan and farmed here until 1928; Nellie, Mrs. F. Eagle of Brandon; Cynthia, who lives in Vancouver and Sidney, also a farmer. Sidney married Ethel Knibbs of Stoughton, Saskatchewan in 1925. As well as farming he did a lot of work with his engine building roads between Cypress River and Holland. He passed away in 1950. His widow and son Jack, carried on the farming till 1961 when Mrs. Bullied bought a home in Treherne. Mr. and Mrs. Sid Bullied's family consisted of two boys and two girls. The girls are Phyllis, Mrs. J. McKenzie of Winnipeg and Joyce, Mrs. R. Riddell. Joyce's husband is in the R.C.A.F. and they have been stationed in Germany and are presently in France. They have three children, Ross, Debbie, and Dwane. Jack Bullied farms the home farm and in 1959 married Gwen Sime. Their children are Johnny, Janice, Bobby and Linda. Raymond spent five years in the air force and is now farming four miles north of Holland. He married Betty Burns of Owen Sound, Ontario in 1956 and they have two sons, Bruce and Brian.
